## Who is eligible to enter?

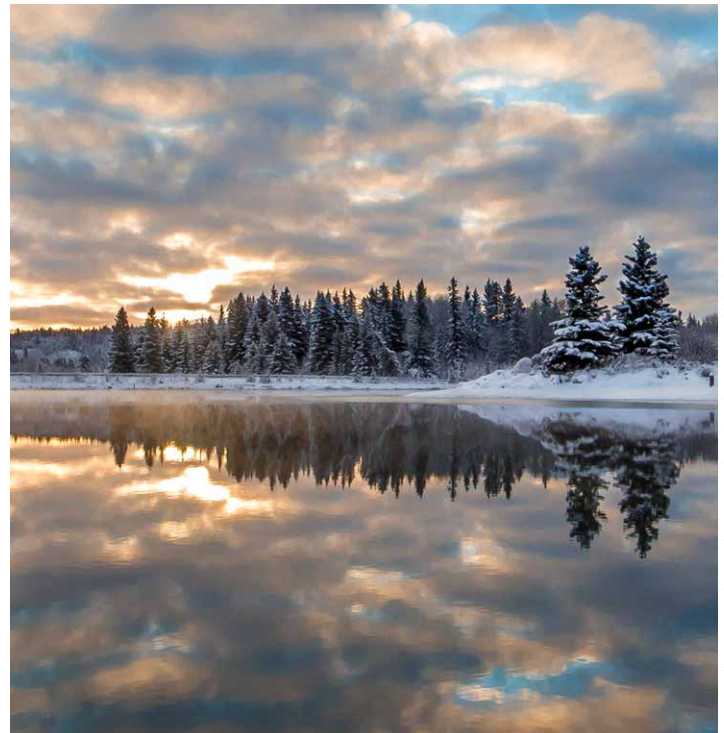
The photography competition is open to anyone who is not a "professional photographer." For the purposes of this competition, a "professional photographer" is defined as one whose primary source of income comes from the sale of their photography products or services. Exceptions apply: see below for full rules. **We retain the right to determine a contributor's eligibility status. Judges' decision is final.**

**\*Prize details:** The total prize pool of \$700 will be awarded as follows. A \$500 cash prize will be awarded to the contributors of the top three photographs selected for inclusion in the Summer 2014 issue of **BRAGG - ABOUT THE CREEK**, as selected by our panel: 1st Prize – \$250; 2nd Prize – \$150; 3rd Prize – \$100. A Canvas Print(s) of the winning submission will also be supplied to the 1st prize winner – total value of up to \$200. This will allow for one 20"x30" Gallery Wrap or a combination of smaller sizes up to a total value of \$200. **Entry conditions:** All non-professional photographs submitted to **BRAGG - ABOUT THE CREEK** will automatically be entered into the seasonally relevant Photography Competition unless specifically requested otherwise by the contributor at the time of submission. Any photographs received after the submission deadline of April 11, 2014 may not be entered into the Summer 2014 competition. **Ineligible for entry:** Professional photographers – defined as someone whose primary source of income comes from the sale of their photography products or services. Also ineligible are employees of **BRAGG - ABOUT THE CREEK**.
